Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the letter dated 14.03.2023 subject of which was "Wrong Claim of IGST Refund on the Exports made under Advance Authorization (AA) Scheme", the respondents are trying to coercively recover part of the amount while terming it as illegtimate refund scheme. Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that he has also challenged vires of Rule 96 sub-Rule 10 of CGST Rules, 2017.



- 2. Learned counsel for Union of India seeks some time to respond on the challenge to the vires, whereas Mr. Rajvendra Sarswat appearing for respondents No.2 and 3 fairly submits that the show-cause notice is yet to be issued to the petitioner, therefore, except for the challenge to the vires, the writ petition is pre-mature.
- 3. The matter requires consideration.
- 4. List the matter on 22.07.2024.
- 5. In the meanwhile, the respondents No.2 and 3 shall not proceed to take any coercive steps against the petitioner without adhering to the statutory requirement of the Rules.
